## SHOREBIRD ID TIPS



## **KEVIN'S RULE OF FOUR**

- 1. Pick one bird from the crowd to ID.
- 2. Narrow it down to a category using the silhouettes on the right.
- 3. Compare the shorebird to others.
- 4. Find three clues to ID. Focus first on **shape**, **size**, and **behavior**, then look at color pattern, markings, habitat, range, and calls.



Bill: Length, curvature, tip pointing up/down, shape (pointy/blunt) Leg Length: Short, medium, long Neck Length: Short, medium, long Body Shape: Compact, elongated



with another bird. The Killdeer is right in the middle on the size scale. **Small shorebirds** are smaller than a Killdeer. **Large shorebirds** are larger than a Killdeer.

## **FORAGING BEHAVIORS**

Peeps: Head down, walk, pick, probe Plover: Run and stop, with occasional hiccup (similar to Solitary Sandpiper's bob-up)

Lesser Yellowlegs: Stroll-and-pick Stilt Sandpiper: Oil derrick up-anddown probing like dowitchers, but

rear tips up

**Long- and Short-billed Dowitchers:** Sewing-machine probing but body

stays horizontal

White-rumped Sandpiper: Tip-up,

tail goes up

Red-necked Phalarope: Swim-andrun (moves all the time) and swimand-spin
